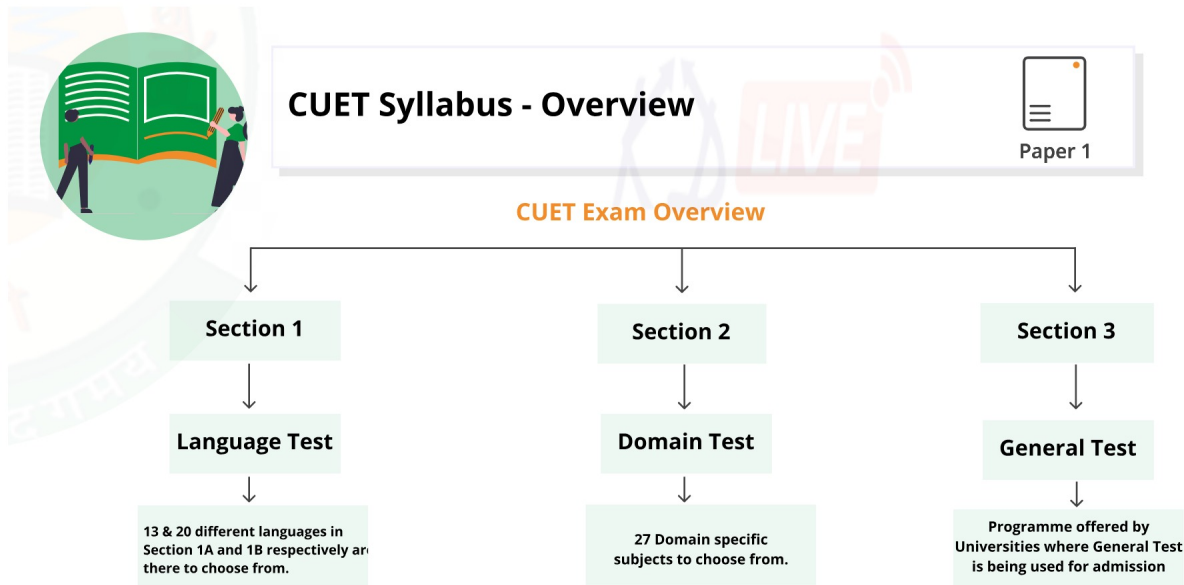

Moreover, the above table clearly demonstrates that 'Biotechnology' and 'Genetics and Evolution' carry the highest weightage.

<b>Chemistry</b>

Alcohol, Phenol and Ethers	3-4
Aldehydes, Ketones and Carboxylic Acids	4-5
Biomolecules	3-4
Chemical Kinetics	4-5
Coordination Compounds	5
D and F Block Elements	4-5

Organic Compounds containing nitrogen	3-4
P Block Elements	3-4
Surface Chemistry	3-4

Hence, we can say that the topic 'Coordination Compounds' carries the highest weightage.

Thus, it is evident that that 'Relations and Functions' carries the highest weightage.

<b>Physics</b>	
<b>Topics</b>	<b>No. of Questions</b>
Current Electricity	3-4
Electromagnetic inductions and Alternating currents	2-3
Electrostatics	5-6
Magnetic Effects of Current and Magnetism	2-3
Optics	7-8
Semiconductor	3-4

Therefore, we can say that 'Optics' carries the highest weightage.

## CUET Syllabus 2023 Section III - General Test

The General Test encompasses six topics:

- General Knowledge
- Current Affairs
- General Mental Ability
- Numerical Ability
- Quantitative Reasoning
- Logical and Analytical Reasoning

Moreover, Quantitative Reasoning further encompasses the following sub-topics: Simple application of basic mathematical concepts, arithmetic, algebra geometry, mensuration, statistics. Now that we are familiar with the CUET Syllabus 2023, let us now take a look at the exam pattern for the same.

## CUET Exam Pattern 2023

Consequently, it is crucial that you are aware of the exam pattern. Moreover, the exam pattern helps you manage your study schedule and time wisely. It acts as a guiding light through this challenging path you are about to take. To begin with, the CUET Examination is an online objective-type examination that consists of three sections- Language Test, Domain Test and General Test.

Moreover, we have attached some images below for your reference, which show the exam pattern that will be followed in the examination.

## CUET Syllabus 2023 - Subject Wise Topics Weightage

Subject combinations for each paper, type of questions in each paper, and mode of examination are given in the table below:

Section	Subjects/ Tests	Questions to be Attempted
<b>Section 1A - Languages</b>	There are <b>13</b> different languages. Any of these languages may be chosen.	40 questions to be attempted out of 50 in each language.
<b>Section 1B - Languages</b>	There are <b>20</b> Languages. Any of these languages may be chosen.	
<b>Section 2 - Domain</b>	There are <b>27</b> Domains specific subjects being offered under this section. A candidate may choose any subject as desired by the applicable University/ Universities.  For any such undergraduate programme / programmes being offered by Universities where a General Test is being used for admission.	<b>35/40</b> Questions to be attempted out of <b>45/50</b> .
<b>Section 3 - General Test</b>		<b>50</b> Questions to be attempted out of <b>60</b>

**Note:**

- From the above subjects / languages, the candidate can choose maximum of 10 subjects from all three Sections.
- Examination will be conducted on multiple days in three shifts, depending on the number of Candidates and Subject choices.

## CUET Marking Scheme 2023

Keeping the CUET syllabus 2023 and the exam pattern in consideration, let's delve into the marking scheme. As it was already highlighted, the CUET examination consists of three sections. Moreover, let us discuss the marking scheme for each of these sections:

- The CUET exam will feature objective type multiple choice questions.
- Moreover, the question papers for CUET (UG) 2023 will be administered in accordance with the National Education Policy (NEP) and offered in 13 languages, including English, Hindi, Assamese, Bengali, Gujarati, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Odia, Punjabi, Tamil, Telugu, and Urdu.
- Additionally, the questions from the Domain subjects will be at a 12th-grade level.
- Lastly, CUET (UG) - 2023 will be exclusively conducted as a Computer-Based Test (CBT).

## CUET Syllabus 2023 - Subject Wise Topics Weightage

This section comprises 50 questions out of which only 40 questions are to be attempted. Furthermore, each question carries a total of 5 marks (a total of 200 marks). However, there is a negative marking of one mark for every incorrect answer.

### Domain Test

This section comprises 45-50 questions out of which only 35-40 questions are to be attempted. Additionally, each question carries a total of 5 marks (a total of 175-200 marks). However, there is a negative marking of one mark for every incorrect answer.

### General Test

This section comprises 60 questions out of which only 50 questions are to be attempted. Moreover, each question carries a total of 5 marks (a total of 250 marks). However, there is a negative marking of one mark for every incorrect answer.

With your understanding of the CUET syllabus 2023, its exam pattern, and the marking scheme, we can now proceed to discuss the marks normalization process.

## CUET 2023 Marks Normalization

Before we take a look at the normalization of marks, why don't we begin by learning what normalization is? Normalization is the statistical method used to bring the marks to an equal level, keeping in mind the difference in the difficulty level of various shifts of the exam. Furthermore, CUET scores are normalized using the **Equi-Percentile method**.

Lastly, it is important to be aware of the exam dates. Hence, as per the official CUET Notification 2023, the important dates you need to keep in mind are as follows:
