The SSC CHSL Computer-Based Examination is divided into two tiers: Tier 1 and Tier 2. Tier 1 comprises 100 objective, multiple-choice questions, with a total of 200 marks. A penalty of 0.50 marks is applied for each incorrect answer, making accuracy crucial for achieving a high score.

Tier 2 is held in two sessions on the same day. Session I includes Section I, Section II, and Module I of Section III, while Session II is dedicated to Module II of Section III. Tier 2 features objective, multiple-choice questions, except for Module II of Section III, and the questions are available in English, Hindi, or any language chosen during the application process.
