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




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

The SSC CHSL Computer Based Examination is structured into two tiers: Tier 1 and Tier 2. Tier 1 consists of 100 Objective Type, Multiple Choice Questions, with a maximum score of 200 marks. Additionally, there is a penalty of 0.50 marks for each incorrect answer, emphasizing the importance of accuracy for maximizing scores.

Moving on to Tier 2, it will be conducted in two sessions on the same day. Session I covers Section II, Section III, and Module I of Section III, while Session II focuses on Module II of Section III. Tier 2 includes Objective Type, Multiple Choice Questions, except for Module II of Section III, and questions are available in English, Hindi, and any other language chosen during the application process.
