

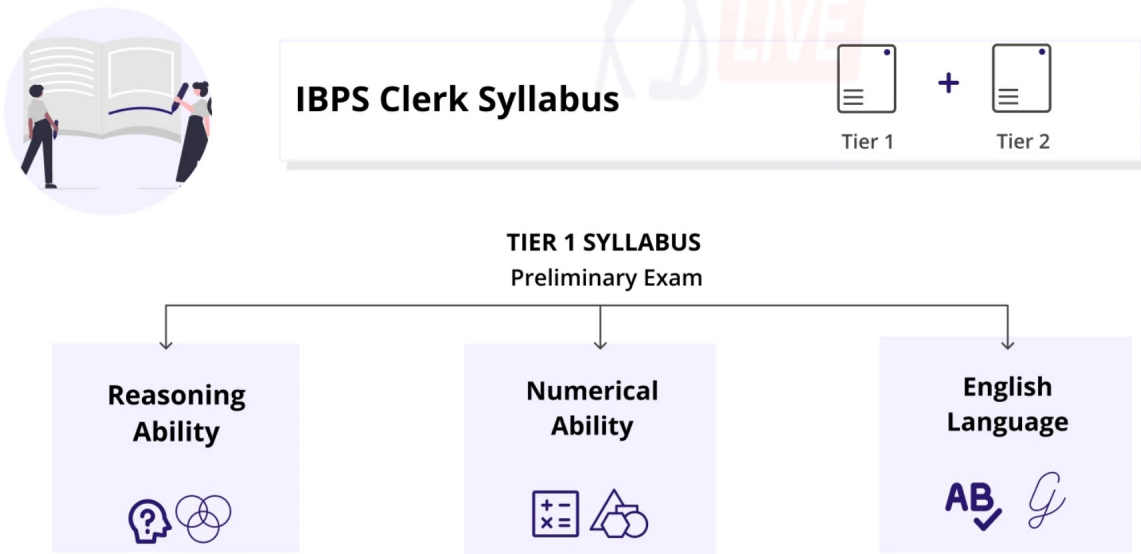

The IBPS Clerk exam is conducted by the Institute of Banking Personnel Selection (IBPS) to hire clerks for various jobs in 11 banks throughout India. Consequently, it presents a great opportunity for all aspiring candidates who are looking to secure their future. Moreover, the IBPS exam is held at two levels.

- 1. Preliminary Examination:** This is the first level of the IBPS Clerk exam. Additionally, during this phase, multiple-choice questions are asked, which serve as a screening test designed to identify a candidate's eligibility for the main examination.
- 2. Main Examination:** The candidates who qualify for the preliminary exam advance to the main examination. This is the second level of the IBPS Clerk exam and is more comprehensive. Also, the main examination is more detailed and plays a significant role in determining the final selection of candidates for clerical positions in banks.

IBPS Clerk Syllabus 2023 - Preliminary Exam

Let us begin with understanding the preliminary examination syllabus. The preliminary exam assesses the candidate's proficiency in the English Language, Numerical Ability, and Reasoning Ability. Likewise, for your easy understanding, we have provided the subject-wise topic weightage below. Also note that all the topics covered under each of these subjects, along with their weightage are calculated based on the previous year's papers, i.e., 2022 and 2021.

Similarly, in Numerical Ability, the most important topics are Arithmetic and, Data Interpretation.

IBPS Clerk Marking Scheme 2023

As stated in the official notification, there will be a penalty for incorrect answers marked in the Objective Tests. Certainly, for each question for which a wrong answer has been given by the candidate, 1/4th or 0.25 of the marks assigned to that question will be deducted as a penalty to arrive at a corrected score. Subsequently, if a question is left blank, i.e., no answer is marked by the candidate, there will be no penalty for that question. Moreover, this is applicable for both Prelims and Mains.

IBPS Clerk 2023 Marks Normalization

Marks normalization, is a statistical technique used to adjust scores in situations where there are variations in the difficulty levels of question papers across different shifts of the same exam. This process ensures fairness by making score comparisons more accurate.

In addition, the corrected scores obtained by each of the candidates in different sessions (if held) will be normalized using the equi-percentile method. Scores up to two decimal points shall be taken for calculations.
