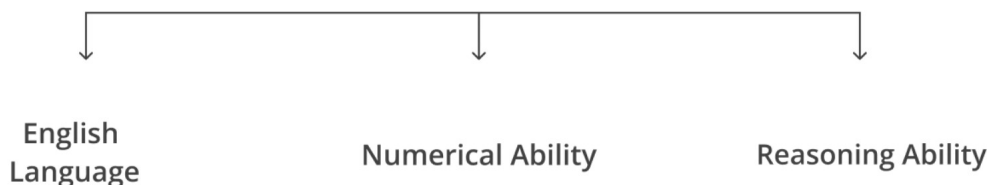

It is evident from the above table that Reading Comprehension carries the highest weightage followed by Cloze Test. However, make sure not to underestimate the importance of the remaining topics.

Note: The Arithmetic topics further include the following sub-topics: Algebra, mensuration, profit and loss, percentage, time and work, time speed distance, pipes and cisterns, ratios and proportions, permutations & combinations, probability etc. Moreover, remember that the weightages of all the sub-topics can range from 0-1.

Moreover, in Numerical Ability, **simplification** is the most asked topic. In order to score well in this, you must aim to have calculations on your fingertips.

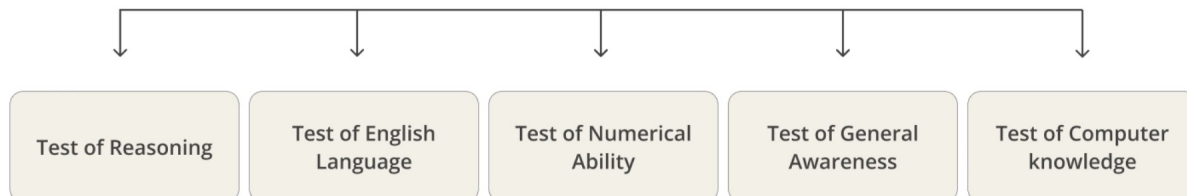

RBI Assistant Exam Pattern 2023

Understanding the exam pattern is the foremost crucial step in exam preparation. It not only helps you answer the question in the right way but also imparts valuable time management skills. Moreover, the exam pattern serves as a roadmap throughout your exam preparation journey. Therefore, let's delve into the RBI Assistant Exam Pattern. The recruitment process for RBI Assistants consists of three stages:

1. Preliminary Examination
2. Main Examination
3. Language Proficiency Test (LPT)

The Preliminary exam will span a duration of 60 minutes and will consist of a total of 100 questions. However, the Mains will encompass a total time allocation of 135 minutes and will comprise 200 questions. RBI Assistant Marking Scheme 2023

- Questions in the Prelims and Mains exams will be provided in both Hindi and English. However, the English Language test will exclusively be available in English. Moreover, to appear in the Mains you will have to qualify for Prelims first. Remember, you will have to qualify in each part of the Objective test separately.
- Furthermore, candidates who qualify for the Mains exam will then appear in the Language Proficiency Test. This test will be administered in the official or local language(s) of the respective state.
- Penalty will be applicable to questions marked incorrectly. In simpler terms, every question answered incorrectly will lead to a deduction of 1/4th mark. Thus, be careful while answering questions in both Prelims and Mains.

RBI Assistant 2023 Marks Normalization

Let's first understand what marks normalization means. It is a method generally used in competitive exams to make scores fair and comparable. Moreover, marks normalization ensures that the final scores accurately reflect a candidate's performance relative to others, even when the exams are not identical in difficulty. Hence, RBI will follow the equipercentile method to accurately measure your score. Moreover, the scores obtained by you will be equated using IBPS' standard practice.
