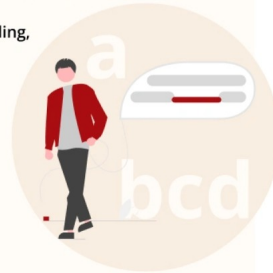

Non-verbal Reasoning (Paper Folding, Cubes and Dices, Counting Figures, Visual Puzzles, etc.)	5 - 7
Data sufficiency	4 - 5
Venn diagram (Venn Diagram, Logical Syllogism etc)	2 - 3
Series (Semantic, Figural, number and mixed series and series based on general knowledge)	3 - 5
Alphabet or word test (Sequence and word formation, Matrix, jumbled words, suffix etc.)	3 - 5
Puzzles (Double line-up arrangements, Circular Arrangements, Seating Arrangements, Linear Arrangements etc.)	3 - 5
Coding-Decoding (Coding decoding by letter shifting, coding by analogy and words)	3 - 5
Missing numbers (Numbers and alphabet-based Matrix and Diagrams)	2 - 3
Direction & Distances (Problems based on network, routes and distances travelled)	1 - 3
Mathematical Reasoning (Word problems, Number and sign interchange, Arithmetic Operations, etc)	1 - 2
Order Ranking (Sequence of order and ranking will be asked from the given data)	1 - 2





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From the above table, you must know that Analogy, Classifications, and Non-Verbal Reasoning hold the maximum weightage when it comes to the Logical Reasoning segment of Paper I of the SSC CPO exam 2024. 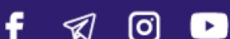
