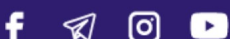

Reasoning Syllabus for SSC CGL Exam 2024 - Exam Pattern

As per the official SSC CGL exam pattern, the examination will be conducted in 2 stages – Tier 1 and Tier 2. Both Tier 1 and Tier 2 exams will be conducted in Computer-based Online mode. The Tier 1 exam comprises 100 questions for a total of 200 marks, with each question carrying 2 marks each. The questions will be objective-type MCQs.

There will be 3 papers in Tier 2 – Paper I (Compulsory for All Posts), Paper II (For Junior Statistical Officer - JSO), and Paper III (For Assistant Audit Officer/Assistant Accounts Officer). Candidates interested in the various positions under the Central Government through the Staff Selection Commission must be aware of the detailed exam pattern for the SSC CGL exam. Below is an infographic for a better understanding of the SSC CGL Exam Pattern 2024:-

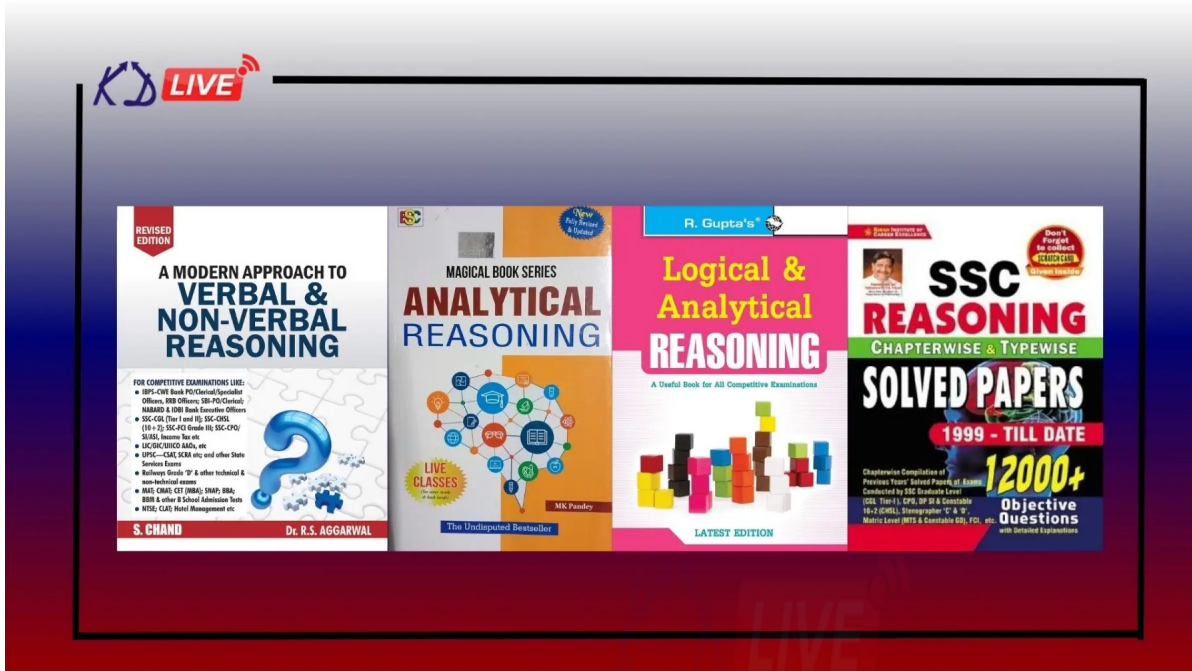
