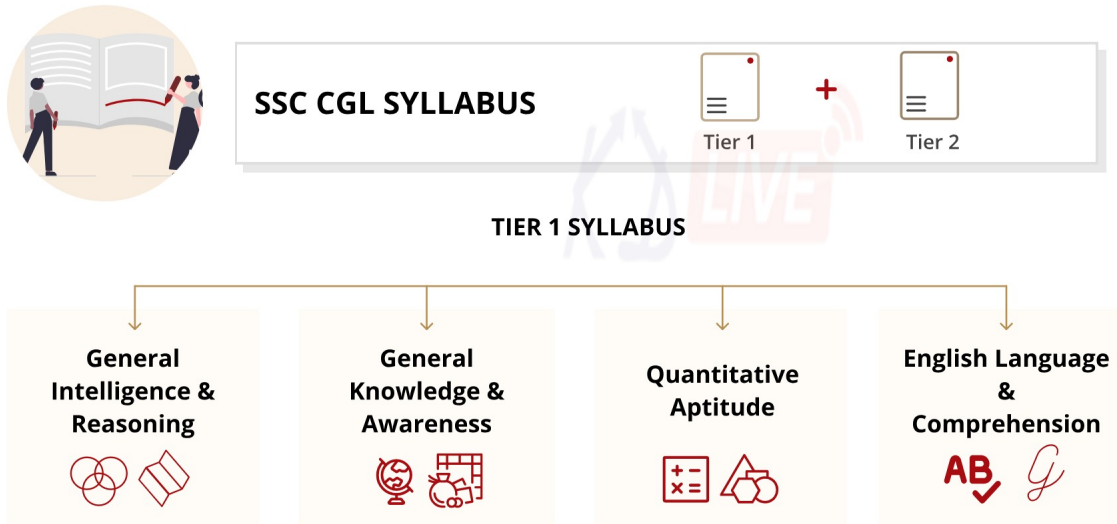

The Tier 2 schedule includes separate shifts/days for Paper 1, Paper 2, and Paper 3.

- Paper 1 is compulsory for all. Further, Paper 2 is specifically for applicants applying for the Junior Statistical Officer (JSO) in the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation.
- Moreover, Paper III is for candidates applying for Assistant Audit Officer/Assistant Accounts Officer roles.
 - **Paper 1:** Mathematical Abilities, Reasoning and General Intelligence, English Language and Comprehension, General Awareness, Computer Knowledge Module and Data Entry Speed Test Module.
 - **Paper 2:** Statistics
 - **Paper 3:** General Studies (Finance and Economics)

To summarize the above table, we can clearly say that Reading Comprehension holds the maximum weightage followed by Sentence Rearrangement / Jumbles, Fillers, and Synonyms and Antonyms.

SSC CGL Marking Scheme 2023

The SSC CGL Exam 2023 consist of 100 questions in the Tier 1 examination, each question is of 2 marks and there is negative marking of 0.5 marks for each wrong answer. Further, Tier 2 examination consist of 3 papers. Paper 1 carries 150 questions + one data entry task. Moreover, Paper 2 that is of Statistics carries 100 questions, and Paper 3 that is of General Studies carries 100 questions.

Moreover, do remember that questions in both Paper 1 and Paper 2 are of 2 marks each. Also, for understanding the minimum marks to be scored by each category candidate, check out the table below :

SSC CGL Marks Normalization 2023

Now that we are fully aware of the SSC CGL syllabus 2023, its exam pattern, and its marking scheme. Let us now discuss what marks normalization actually is. How about we begin with understanding what marks normalization is? Well, it is a statistical method that accounts for any disparities in the difficulty levels of question papers across multiple shifts of the same exam. Since different shifts can have varying levels of complexity in their questions, direct score comparison might not be equitable. Thus, normalization addresses this issue by equalizing the scores, enabling a more just evaluation of candidates.

In addition, SSC published the formula that will be followed in [Notice No.1-1/2018-P&P-I dated 07-02-2019](#). Subsequently, these normalized scores are utilized to determine the final merit and cut-off marks.

SSC CGL 2023 Exam Dates

Now that you are fully equipped with the SSC CGL syllabus 2023. Let us move forward to analyse the exam dates for the CGL examination. The staff selection commission of India released the SSC CGL Notification 2023 on 3rd April 2023. This official notification provided all important details of the SSC CGL Examination. Further, the table below shows a detail of the **important dates** in the **notification** released on the **official website of SSC**.
