The SSC CHSL Computer Based examination is divided into two tiers: Tier 1 and Tier 2. Tier 1 comprises 100 Objective Type, Multiple Choice Questions with a maximum score of 200 marks. Moreover, there is a penalty of 0.50 marks for each incorrect answer, making accuracy crucial for maximizing scores.

Moving on to Tier 2, Tier 2 of the SSC CHSL exam will be conducted in two sessions on the same day. Session I will cover Section I, Section II, and Module I of Section III, while Session II will focus on Module II of Section III. Tier 2 will consist of Objective Type, Multiple Choice Questions, except for Module II of Section III. The questions will be available in English, Hindi, and any other language chosen by you during the application process.

SSC CHSL Marks Normalization

Let's now explore the concept of marks normalization. A statistical method called "marks normalization" is used to account for differences in question paper difficulty between exam shifts. Through score equalization, this technique promotes impartiality and allows for a more realistic evaluation of your performance even in the face of varying question difficulty.

To ensure fairness, normalization equalizes scores using a standardized formula. SSC has released a formula for this purpose, detailed in

. These normalized scores are crucial in determining cut-off marks and compiling the merit list.
