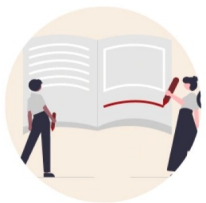

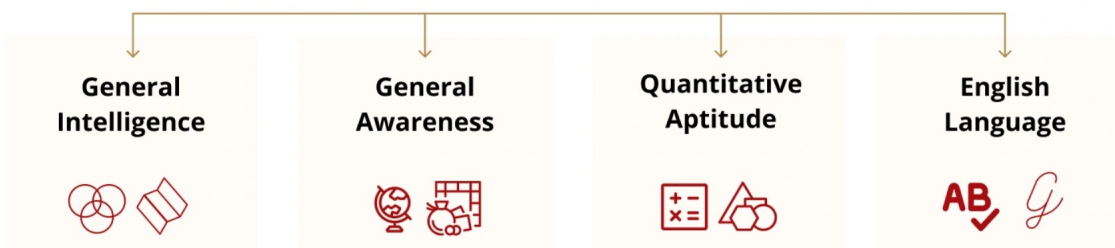

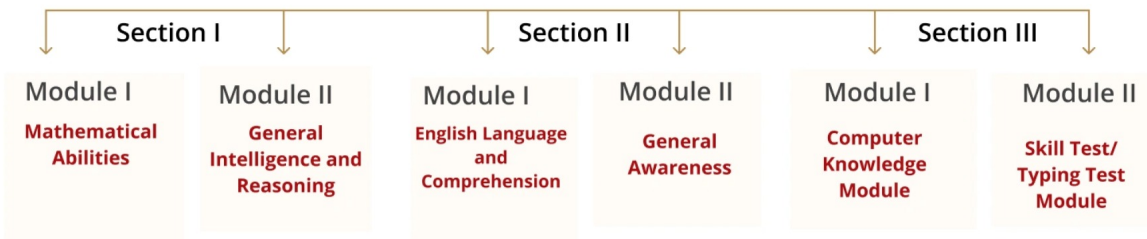

The SSC CHSL Computer Based examination is divided into two tiers: Tier 1 and Tier 2. Tier 1 consists of 100 Objective Type, Multiple Choice Questions, with a maximum score of 200 marks. There is a penalty of 0.50 marks for each incorrect answer, making accuracy essential for maximizing your score.

## SSC CHSL Exam Syllabus - Subject Wise Topics Weightage

Tier 2 of the SSC CHSL exam will be conducted in two sessions on the same day. Session I will include Section I, Section II, and Module I of Section III, while Session II will cover Module II of Section III. Except for Module II of Section III, Tier 2 will feature Objective Type, Multiple Choice Questions. The questions will be available in English, Hindi, and any other language you selected during the application process.

## SSC CHSL Marks Normalization

Let's begin by understanding the concept of normalization. Normalization is a statistical technique that accounts for variations in the difficulty levels of question papers across different shifts of the same examination. A direct comparison of scores might not be fair due to potential differences in the complexity of questions in various shifts. To ensure a more equitable evaluation of candidates, normalization equalizes the scores.

To address this issue, SSC has released a formula, as outlined in

. These standardized scores will be used to determine the cut-off marks, which will subsequently contribute to the compilation of the merit list.
