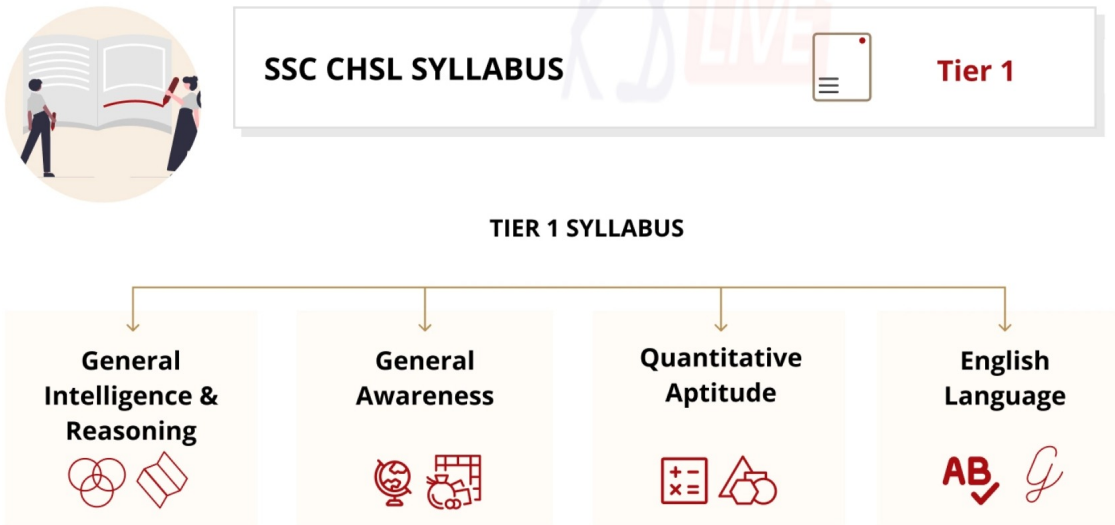

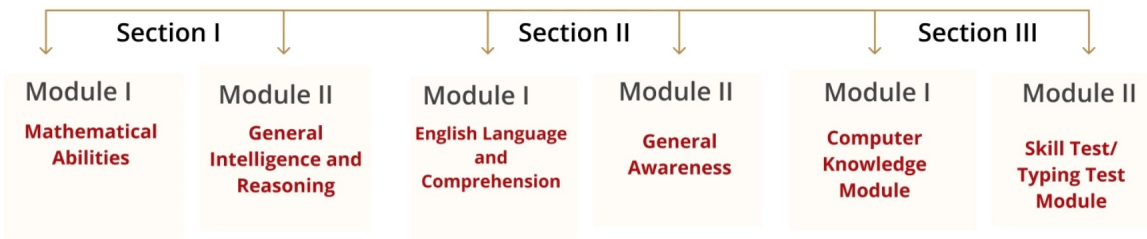

The SSC CHSL exam comprises two Tiers. Firstly, Tier-1 is an objective-type multiple-choice exam covering the aforementioned four subjects. It's important to note that Tier-1 includes a negative marking of 0.5 marks for each wrong answer. Regarding Tier-2, same as last year, the exam will be conducted in two sessions, namely Session-I and Session-II, both on the same day. Notably, in Session I, the exam includes Section I, Section II, and Module I of Section III. Additionally, this Tier features a negative marking of 1 mark for each wrong answer in Section I, Section II, and Module I of Section III.
