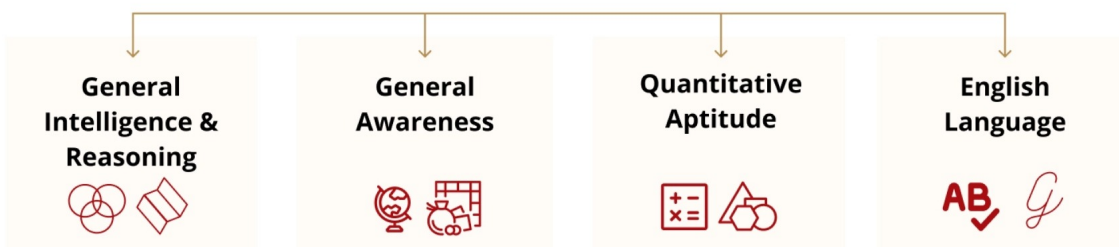

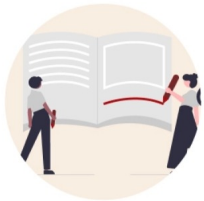

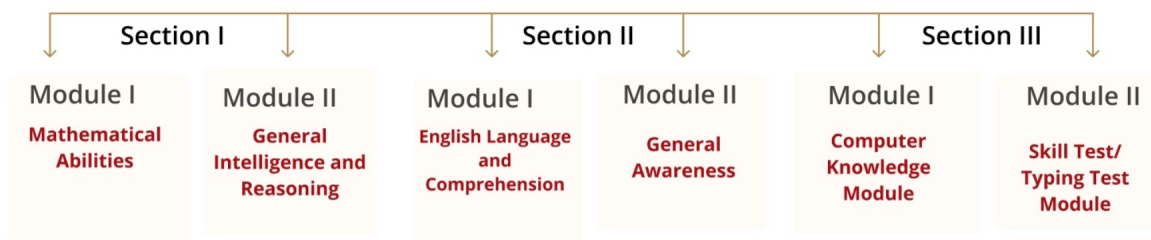

## SSC CHSL Syllabus 2024 - Tier 2

To begin with, since 2022, the Tier 2 exam has been divided into two separate sessions: Session-I and Session-II, both held on the same day. Secondly, it's important to acknowledge that Session-I will encompass the administration of Section-I: Module I and II, Section-II: Module I and II, and Section-III: Module I. On the other hand, Session-II will focus on Section III: Module III. To facilitate your comprehension, we have provided the bifurcation of Tier 2 in detail. Additionally, this tier incorporates a penalty of 1 mark for each incorrect answer but only in Section 1, Section 2 and Module 1 of Section 3.

## SSC CHSL Marking Scheme 2024

As known, the SSC CHSL examination is organized in two tiers. To elaborate, both tiers consist of objective-type multiple-choice questions. Refer to the following guidelines for clarity:

- In Tier 1, you will receive 2 marks for every correct answer.
- There is a penalty of 0.50 marks for each incorrect response.
- In Tier 2, each correct answer is rewarded with 3 marks, but for every incorrect answer, 1 mark will be deducted. However, only in Section 1, Section 2 and Module 1 of Section 3.

## SSC CHSL Marks Normalization 2024

Let's begin by understanding the concept of normalization. Normalization is a statistical technique that takes into account variations in the difficulty levels of question papers across different shifts of the same examination. A direct comparison of scores might not be fair due to potential differences in the complexity of questions in various shifts. To ensure a more equitable evaluation of candidates, normalization addresses this issue by equalizing the scores.

Therefore, SSC has released a formula, as outlined in [Notice No.1-1/2018-P&P-I dated 07-02-2019](#). These standardized scores will be utilized to determine the cut-off marks, subsequently contributing to the compilation of the merit list.

## SSC CHSL Exam Dates 2024

The SSC CHSL Notification for the year 2024 was unveiled on 8th April 2024.
