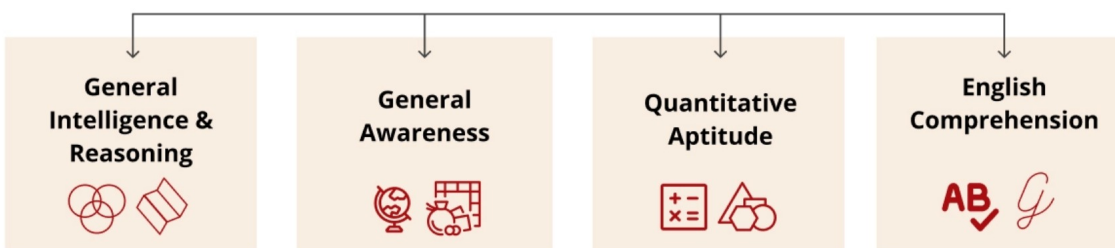

- Tier 1 features Objective Type multiple-choice questions. Questions will be available in both English and Hindi, except for English Comprehension.
- Each incorrect answer incurs a negative marking penalty of 0.50 marks.

SSC Combined Graduate Level Exam Tier 1 Marks Normalization

Now that we have a solid understanding of the exam format and SSC Combined Graduate Level Exam syllabus Tier 1, let's explore the idea of mark normalization. Let's see what marks normalization comprises first. It is essentially a statistical technique intended to account for any differences in question paper difficulty between shifts of the same exam. A direct comparison of scores may not be fair since various shifts may have varying levels of question complexity. Consequently, normalization ensures an easier evaluation of applicants by comparing the scores, resolving this issue.

Furthermore, SSC has published the formula for normalization in

. Subsequently, these normalized scores are utilized to determine the final merit and cut-off marks.
