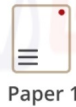

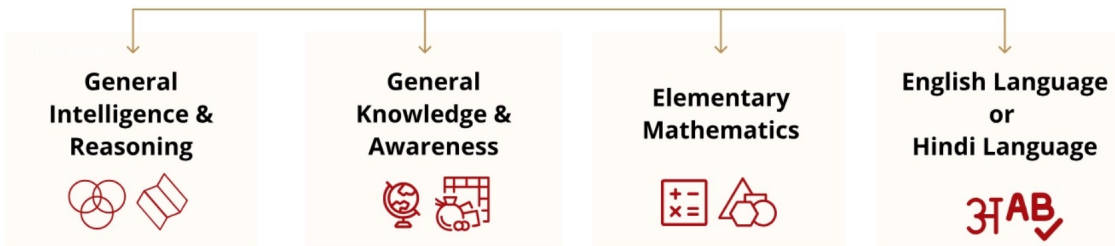

SSC GD Constable Syllabus - Subject Wise Topics Weightage

First and foremost, you must be aware that the SSC GD Constable examination comprises three stages- The Computer Based Examination, the Physical Efficiency test and the Physical Standard Test. Moreover, the Computer-Based Examination comprises four main subjects:

- General Intelligence and Reasoning
- General Knowledge and General Awareness
- Elementary Mathematics
- English/Hindi Language

Further, it is essential to note that the SSC GD Constable Syllabus has remained constant over the past years. Now that you're familiar with the subjects included in the SSC GD Constable Syllabus, let's proceed to explore the specific topics within these subjects and their respective weights.

SSC GD Constable Syllabus - Computer Based Examination

Let's start by examining the SSC GD Constable Syllabus for the computer-based examination. The GD Constable exam features a single computer-based test. As explained earlier, this examination includes four primary subjects -

Thus, based on the provided table, it is evident that topics such as 'Analogy,' 'Alphabet or Word Test,' 'Order Ranking,' 'Venn Diagram,' 'Coding-Decoding,' and 'Puzzle' carry the highest weightage. Consequently, focusing more effort on mastering these topics is essential.

General Knowledge and General Awareness

Consequently, according to the table above, it is apparent that 'General Polity' and 'Science' are the topics with the highest weightage. It is crucial to give these topics special emphasis and focus during your preparation.

Thus, according to the provided table, it is apparent that the topic 'वाक्यों में त्रुटी' holds the highest weightage.

SSC GD Constable Syllabus - Physical Efficiency Test

Subsequently, upon successfully passing the Computer-Based Examination, you become eligible to participate in the Physical Efficiency Test. During the Physical Efficiency Test (PET), candidates are obligated to partake in a race. The designated time and distance standards for this race vary depending on the gender. For a detailed comprehension of these criteria, please refer to the table presented below

	Male	Female	Remarks
Race	5 Kms in 24 mins	1.6 Kms in 8.5 mins	For candidates other than those belonging to the Ladakh Region
	1.6 km in 6.5 mins	800 metres in 4 mins	For candidates of the Ladakh Region

Nevertheless, the SSC issued a

notice

amending the GD Constable Notification, particularly addressing the issue of pregnancy in women during the Physical Efficiency Test (PET) and Physical Standard Test (PST). According to this notice, every female candidate is required to sign a self-declaration confirming their pregnancy status. This notice will also be applicable to every forthcoming SSC GD Constable examinations.

- **In case of a false declaration**, the candidate will be held accountable for any risks or mishaps.
- **In case of a pregnancy declaration**, the candidate will be deemed unfit for appearing in the test. However, her vacancy will be kept reserved for her.
- **In case the candidate is found negative for pregnancy**, she will be permitted to appear in the PET/ PST.

SSC GD Constable Exam - Physical Standard Test

We trust that we have addressed any uncertainties you may have had about the GD Constable Computer-Based Examination (CBE). Having resolved queries related to the SSC GD Constable Syllabus, let's shift our focus to the Physical Standard Test. The Physical Standard Test involves three primary criteria for positions under GD Constable:

- Height
- Chest
- Weight

Let's now briefly review these standards.

Height

The height criteria differ for male and female candidates:

- **Male:** 170 cm
- **Female:** 157 cm

However, certain categories offer relaxation options for the mentioned standards. For more information on these relaxations, be sure to refer to our blog on

Chest

The chest measurement requirements for male candidates are outlined as follows:

- **Un-expanded:** 80 cm
- **Minimum expansion:** 5 cm

However, chest measurements are not applicable for female candidates. Furthermore, specific categories may have relaxations for these standards.

Weight

In general, the candidate's weight should be in proportion to their height and age, adhering to medical standards.

SSC GD Constable Exam Pattern

Having acquired an understanding of the SSC GD Constable Syllabus, it is crucial to comprehend the examination format before commencing your preparation. The SSC GD Constable Syllabus includes a Computer-Based Examination, followed by a Physical Efficiency Test (PET), a Physical Standard Test (PST), and, finally, a Detailed Medical Examination.

This image outlines the weightage assigned to each subject along with the duration of the examination. Therefore, it is crucial to thoroughly review this image and subsequently structure your study plan accordingly.

Computer Based Examination: The Computer based examination will consist of one objective type paper containing 80 questions carrying 2 marks each, with the following composition:

All subjects will feature objective-type questions, and the examination is accessible in both English and Hindi, providing candidates with the option to choose their preferred language. SSC GD Constable Marking Scheme

We have now unveiled all the essential information about the SSC GD Constable Syllabus and its exam pattern. Following that, it is imperative for you to understand the marking scheme for the examination. Acquainting yourself with the marking scheme will aid in preparing for the expectations in the examination. Therefore, the SSC GD Constable exam consists of a total of 80 questions, and each question holds a weightage of 2 marks.

Nevertheless, it is crucial to recognize that in the 2024 GD Constable exam, each incorrect answer will result in a deduction of 0.25 marks. However, the GD Constable 2023 exam led to a deduction of 0.50 marks for wrong answers. Furthermore, candidates are allotted a time frame of 60 minutes to tackle all the questions. It's noteworthy that passing this exam is not considered challenging, given that the question difficulty corresponds to the level of high school education.

SSC GD Constable Syllabus - Subject Wise Topics Weightage

To start, let's first understand the concept of normalization. Normalization is a statistical technique that accounts for variations in the difficulty levels of question papers across different shifts of the same examination. A direct comparison of scores may not be fair due to potential differences in the complexity of questions among shifts. To ensure a more equitable evaluation of candidates, normalization addresses this issue by equalizing the scores.

Hence, SSC published the formula that will be followed in

Notice No.1-1/2018-P&P-I dated 07-02-2019

. These standardized scores will be utilized to determine the cut-off marks, ultimately resulting in the creation of the merit list.
