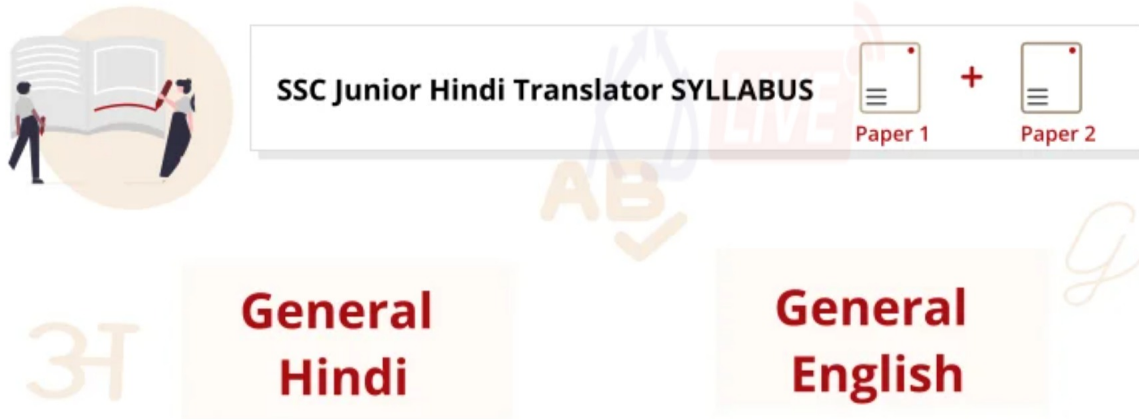

Let us begin by understanding the SSC JHT Syllabus 2023 for Paper 1. SSC JHT Paper 1 will be a Computer Based Exam. The examination will comprise objective-type multiple-choice questions, focusing on two subjects: General Hindi and General English.

The questions will be designed to test the candidate's understanding of the languages and literature, correct use of words, phrases, and idioms, and ability to write the languages correctly, precisely, and effectively. Furthermore, the questions will be at the degree level. **There will be a negative marking of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer in Paper 1.** Therefore, candidates should keep this in mind while answering the question.

#### Paper 1: Objective type (MCQ questions)

- Total number of questions: 200
- Maximum marks: 200
  - General Hindi: 100 questions and 100 marks
  - General English: 100 questions and 100 marks
- Time duration: 2 hours

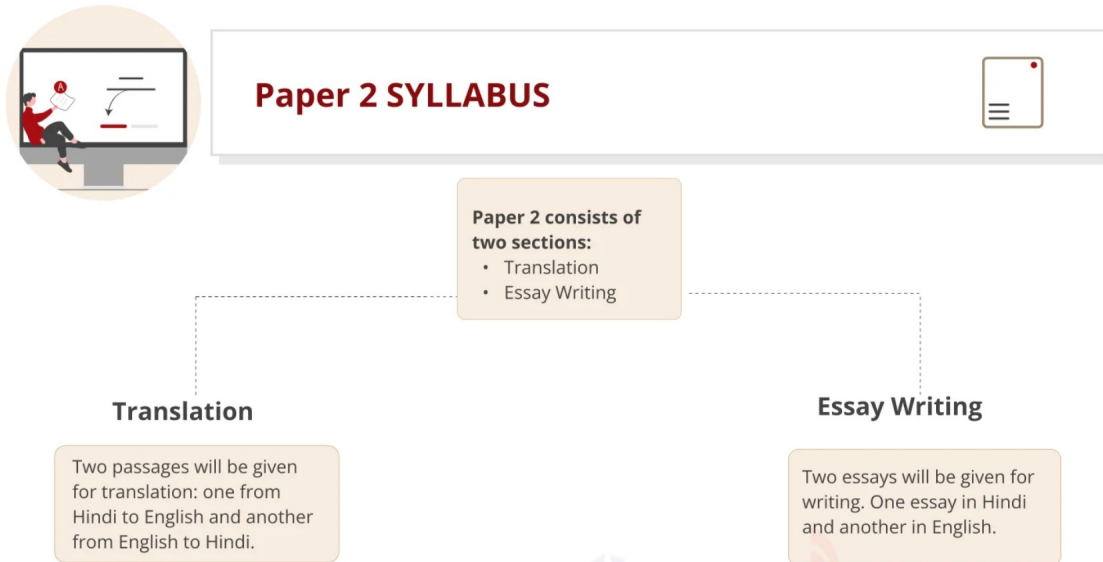

## SSC JHT Paper 2 Syllabus 2023

Candidates qualifying for Paper 1 will then have to appear for Paper 2. Moreover, Paper 2 will consist of two sections, i.e., Translation and Essay. The image below will help you understand each of these sections individually.

- One passage for translation from Hindi to English and another passage for translation from English to Hindi
- An essay each in Hindi and English to test the candidate's translation skills and their ability to write as well as comprehend the two languages correctly, precisely, and effectively.

As stated in the official notification, the paper's level will align with the prescribed educational qualifications. The time given to the candidates to complete the exam will be **two hours**. In addition, there will be no negative markings on Paper 2.

## SSC JHT Exam Pattern 2023

## SSC JHT Marking Scheme 2023

As we are aware, the SSC JHT exam consists of two papers, of which Paper 1 is a multiple-choice computer-based test. Whereas, Paper 2 is a descriptive one. Thus, Paper 1 consists of 100 questions for 1 mark each. However, for every wrong answer, there is a penalty of 0.25 marks, i.e., 1 mark for 4 errors. On the other hand, Paper 2 has no such negative marking.

Now that you are in alignment with the marking scheme, exam pattern, and syllabus, let's gain some knowledge about some important dates.

## SSC JHT Marks Normalization 2023

What do you mean by normalization? It is a statistical method that accounts for any disparities in the difficulty levels of question papers across multiple shifts of the same exam. Since different shifts can have varying levels of complexity in their questions, a direct score comparison might not be equitable. Thus, normalization addresses this issue by equalizing the scores, enabling a more just evaluation of candidates.

Moreover, marks scored by candidates in the computer-based examination will be normalized using the formula published by the Commission through [Notice No.1-1/2018-P&P-I dated 07-02-2019](#) and such normalized scores will be used to determine final merit and [cut-off marks](#).
