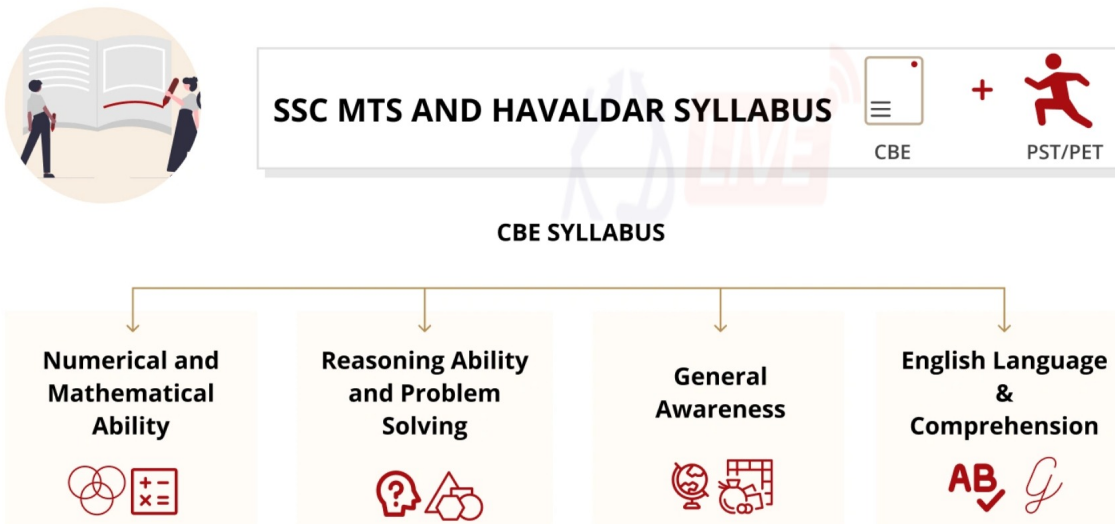

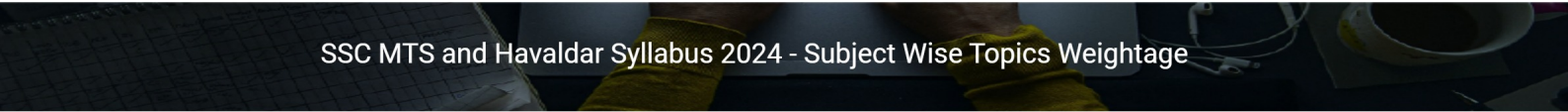

Following the Computer Based Examination, a Physical Efficiency Test/Physical Standard Test (PST) is conducted specifically for the Havaladar position.

Physical Standard Test (PST) - The prescribed minimum physical standards for the Havaldar position in CBIC and CBN are as follows

157.5 cm, with a relaxation of 5 cm for Garhwalis, Assamese, Gorkhas, and individuals from Schedule Tribes.	Chest measurement is 81 cm when fully expanded, with a minimum expansion of 5 cm.

152 cms, with a relaxation of 2.5 cms for Garhwalis, Assamese, Gorkhas, and individuals from Schedule Tribes.	48 kg, with a relaxation of 2 kg for Garhwalis, Assamese, Gorkhas, and individuals from Schedule Tribes.

SSC MTS and Havaladar Syllabus 2024 - Subject Wise Topics Weightage

Following the final result, you are required to undergo Document Verification. During this process, you must provide your Matriculation/Secondary Certificate, equivalence details, Caste/Category Certificate, and the necessary certificates for Persons with Disabilities, Ex-Servicemen, and age relaxation. Additionally, Government employees will need to provide a 'No Objection Certificate'.

SSC MTS and Havaladar Exam Pattern 2024

The Computer Based Examination is a multiple-choice, objective-type test offered in 15 languages, including English and Hindi. You are required to participate in both Session I and Session II of the SSC MTS and Havaladar Syllabus 2024 on the same day. Failure to attempt any of these processes will result in disqualification.

Furthermore, if you are eligible for a scribe, you must be allotted 60 minutes, which amounts to an extra 15 minutes in each of these sessions.

- Session-I of the SSC MTS and Havaldar examination 2024 lasts for 45 minutes, after which it automatically closes.
- Following this, Session-II of the SSC MTS and Havaldar examination 2024 begins, also lasting 45 minutes, thereby concluding the entire Computer Based Examination.
- Session 1 comprises 40 questions, and Session 2 includes 50 questions.
- Each question in both sessions is worth 3 marks.
- There is no negative marking in the first session, while the second session incurs a penalty of one mark for each incorrect answer.
