
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SSC MTS Notification 2024

The Computer-Based Examination will be conducted in two sessions: Session I and Session II, both on the same day and both are mandatory. Each session includes two subjects. In Session I, there are 20 questions per subject, while Session II has 25 questions per subject. You will have 45 minutes to complete each session, after which the session will automatically close. The SSC MTS 2024 exam will consist of Objective Type Multiple Choice Questions. Notably, there is no negative marking in Session I, but in Session II, one mark will be deducted for each incorrect answer. Be mindful of this when answering the questions.

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
