

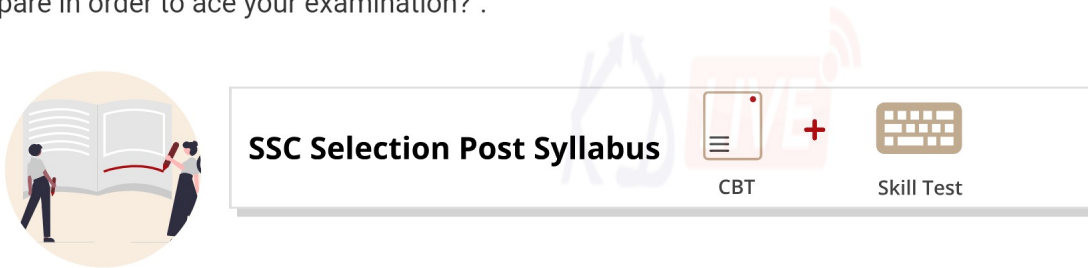

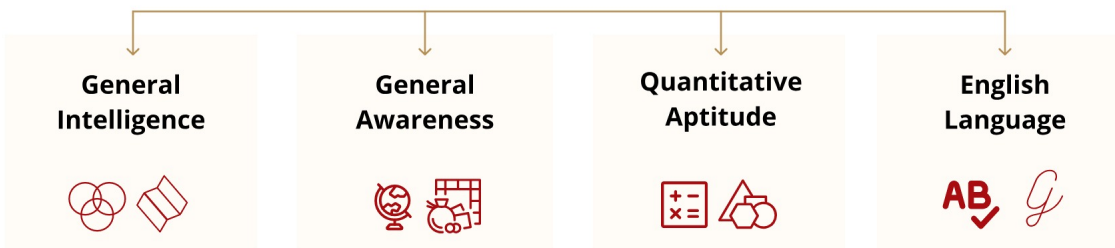

## SSC Selection Post Marking Scheme 2023

Further, let us discuss the marking scheme for the examination. Each of the computer-based examinations consists of 100 questions of 2 marks each (a total of 200 marks). There will be a negative marking of 0.50 marks for every incorrect answer. Moreover, there will be three CBEs of Matriculation level, Higher Secondary (10+2) Level and Graduation & above Level. Now that you are aware of the marking scheme, let's move forth.

## SSC Selection Post 2023 Marks Normalization

Now that we are familiar with the SSC Selection Post Syllabus 2023 and its marking scheme, let's take a look at the marks normalization. First and foremost, why don't we learn what 'Normalization' actually means? Normalization refers to the statistical method through which we bring the marks at an equal level taking into account the difference in the difficulty level of various shifts of the exam.

Consequently, the SSC Selection Post Notification 2023 stated that the marks scored by candidates in Computer Based Examination will be normalized by using the formula published by the Commission through [Notice No: 1-1/2018-P&P-I dated 07-02-2019](#). Further, these normalized scores help calculate your final merit and cut-off marks.

## SSC Selection Post 2023 Exam Dates

Lastly, the Staff Selection Commission of India released the [SSC Selection Post Notification](#) 2023 on 6th March 2023. This notification shed light on the exam dates for the examination along with other important details as well. Further, we have attached a table below from the official notification highlighting the important dates regarding the SSC Selection Post 2023.
