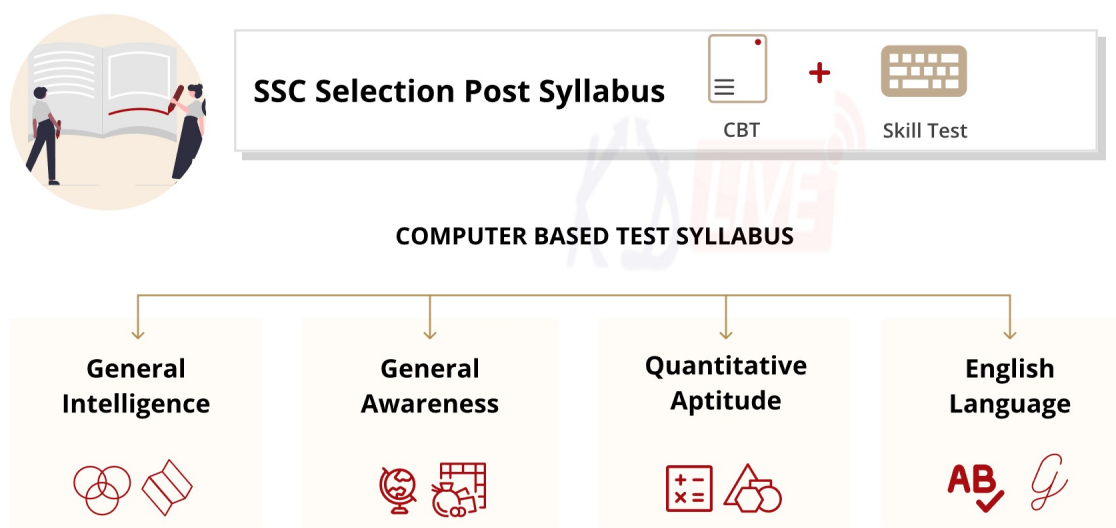

SSC Selection Post Marking Scheme 2024

Next, let's review the marking scheme for the exam. Each computer-based test features 100 questions, each worth 2 marks, totaling 200 marks. There will be a penalty of 0.50 marks for each incorrect answer. Additionally, there will be three levels of computer-based exams: Matriculation level, Higher Secondary (10+2) level, and Graduation & above level. Now that you understand the marking scheme, let's proceed.

SSC Selection Post 2024 Marks Normalization

Now that you're familiar with the SSC Selection Post Syllabus 2024 and its marking scheme, let's dive into marks normalization. But first, what exactly does 'Normalization' mean? It's a statistical method used to adjust scores to a common scale, accounting for variations in difficulty across different exam shifts.

According to the SSC Selection Post Notification 2024, the marks from the Computer-Based Examination will be normalized using a formula published by the Commission in [Notice No: 1-1/2018-P&P-I dated 07-02-2019](#). This process ensures fairness and accuracy in calculating your final merit and cut-off marks.

SSC Selection Post 2024 Exam Dates

The SSC Selection Post Phase 12 Exam Dates for 2024 have been announced. Paper 1 is scheduled for June 20th, 21st, 24th, 25th, and 26th, 2024. The [notification for Phase XII](#) of the SSC Selection Post 2024 cycle was released on February 26, 2024. This exam is designed to shortlist candidates for a variety of posts across the 10th, 12th, and graduate levels. For more detailed information, keep reading.
