Today in 1997 Krishan Kant became the 10th Vice president of India

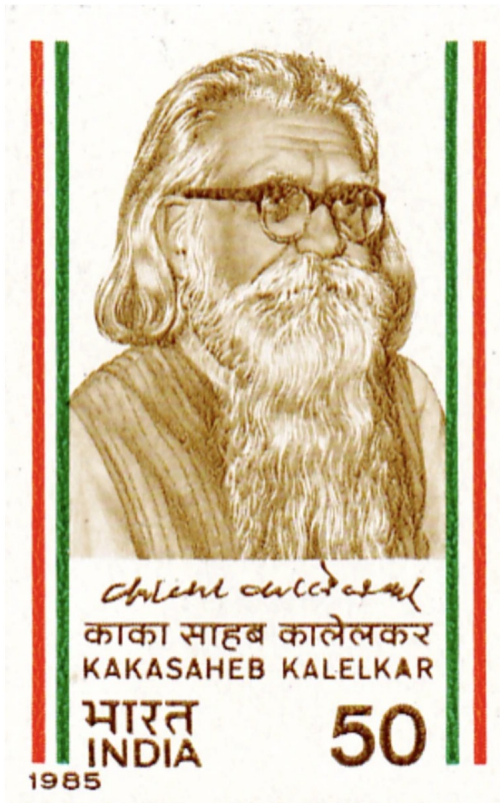


Today in History - What happened on August 21st in History
