Today in 1847 Annie Besant was born in London

Annie Besant was a British socialist, theosophist, women's rights activist, writer, orator, educationist, and philanthropist. Regarded as a champion of human freedom, she was an ardent supporter of both Irish and Indian self-rule. She was a prolific author with over three hundred books and pamphlets to her credit.

Today in 1971 World's first CT scan was performed at Atkinson Morley Hospital, London

The world's first CAT or CT brain scan was performed at Atkinson Morley Hospital, Wimbledon, UK. Hailed as the biggest medical breakthrough since the stethoscope and the discovery of x-rays, the brain scan was performed by Sir Godfrey Hounsfield and Dr Jamie Ambrose. CT scanning was a revolutionary technology that dramatically improved patient safety by providing a non-invasive method to diagnose illness.

Today in 1842 S. Subramania Iyer, freedom fighter and Co founder of Home Rule Movement, was born

Sir Subbier Subramania Iyer was an Indian lawyer, jurist and freedom fighter who, along with Annie Besant, founded the Home Rule Movement. He was popularly known as the "Grand Old Man of South India". Subramania Iyer was born in the Madurai district of Madras Presidency.
