Today in 1943 The Provisional Government of Free India was established

It was established as the Government in exile in Singapore by Indians in exile headed by Subhash Chandra Bose. It was also called Azad Hind or Free India. It was established with Financial, Political and military support from Imperial Japan.

Today in 1577 the City of Amritsar was established by Sikh Guru Ramdas

Historically known as Ramdaspur it is the second largest city in the Indian state of Punjab. Guru Ramdas the fourth Sikh guru is credited with founding the holy city of Amritsar in the Sikh tradition.

Today in 1887 Dr Sri Krishna Sinha, politician and revolutionist leader, was born at Khanwa

He was also known as Shri Babu and was the first chief minister of the Indian state of Bihar. Sinha is regarded amongst the Architects of Modern Bihar. He also led the Dalit entry into the Baidyanath Dham Temple.
