I welcome you all to "Today in History". Here, we will discuss some of the major events in the history of 30th of October, 302nd day of the year 2023.

Today in 1909 Father of Indian Nuclear Programme Homi Jehangir Bhabha was born in bombay

He established the Cosmic Ray Research Institute at IISC. He set up the Tata institute of Fundamental Research in 1945 and also the Atomic Energy Commission in 1948. He died in a plane crash near Mont Blanc in swiss alps while on his way to Vienna.

Today in 1883 Founder of Arya Samaj Dayanand Saraswati died

He was an Indian Philosopher and a social leader He was the first to give a call for Swaraj as India for Indians in 1876, a call later taken up by Lokmanya Tilak. He was assassinated in 1883 in Ajmer.

Today in 2014 Sweden became the first EU member to officially recognise the state of Palestine

As of 2020, 9 out of 28 EU member states recognise Palestine. Relations between EU and PLO were established in 1975 as part of Euro-Arab Dialogue. The EU is member of the Quartet and is single largest donor of foreign aid to Palestinian authority.
