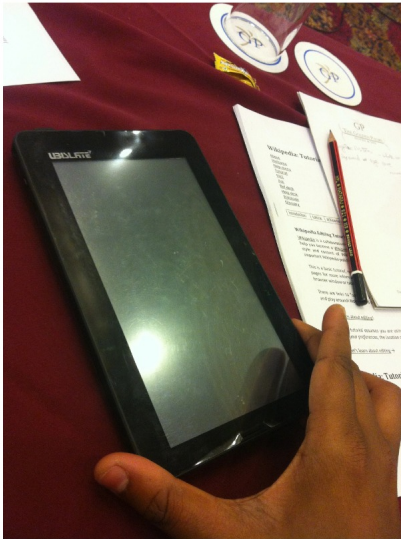


Today in History - What happened on October 5th in History

Today in 2011 Android Tablet "Aakash" was launched by the Indian Government

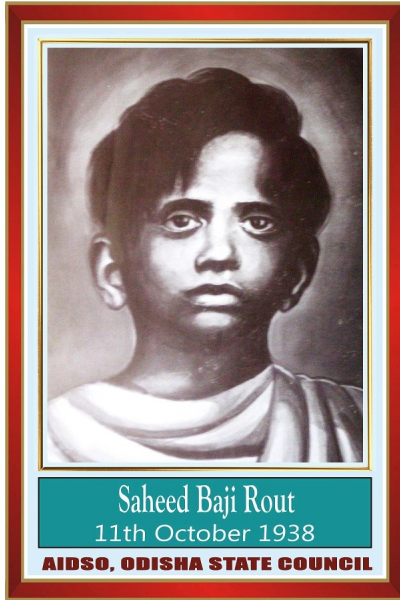
