## Today in 1948 Nizam of Hyderabad surrendered to the Indian Union

Nizam of Hyderabad Asaf Jah VII announced a ceasefire of all military operations against the Indian Army which had entered with intention of annexing it to the Indian Union. Hyderabad was the first kingdom to enter into a subsidiary alliance with the British government in 1798. The Indian Army named the operation as Operation Polo.


### Today in 1965 the Battle of Chawinda was fought between India and Pakistan
