I welcome you all to "Today in History". Here, we will discuss some of the major events in the history of 22nd of September, 264th day of the year 2023.


### Today in 1539 Founder of Sikhism, Guru Nanak Dev Ji died


Since then the UK has accepted only two requests for extradition of a fugitive living in that country. All other requests remain pending till date. Extradition proceedings are slow in the UK.

The Iran-Iraq War dragged on in a stalemate until 1988, when both countries accepted a cease-fire that ended the fighting. Despite the large foreign debt with which Iraq found itself saddled by war's end, Saddam continued to build up his armed forces. In August 1990 the Iraqi army overran neighbouring Kuwait.
