The Act provided for establishment of a broadcasting corporation of India called Prasar Bharti. The act came into effect on 15 September 1997. The Act brought both DD and AIR under the ambit of the corporation Prasar Bharti. Prasar Bharti is India's Public Service Broadcaster.

Today in 1965 India crossed the International Border with Pakistan (Radcliffe Line) making an official beginning of the Indo-Pak border
