1. II is the cause and I is its possible effect
2. I is the cause and II is its possible effect
3. Both I and II are effects of independent causes
4. Both I and II are independent causes

Analytical Reasoning Questions Solution

The correct answer is **Option 2** i.e. **I is the cause and II is its possible effect**

Based on these statements, it can be concluded that Statement II is the effect of Statement I. The anticipated GDP growth of India ranging from 6% to 6.5% in FY24 is primarily attributed to the robust performance in the agriculture sector, recovery in industrial growth, and resilience in the services sector. These factors are expected to stimulate economic activity, leading to increased production, employment, and income generation. As a result, the overall GDP of India is projected to experience positive growth. Economic forecasts are subject to various factors, and the actual growth rate may differ from the projections.

Hence, the correct answer is **I is the cause and II is its possible effect**.
