Read both the statements in each question and mark your answer as: I. If statement I is the cause and statement II is its effect; II. If Statement II is the cause and statement I is its effect; III. If both the statements I and II are independent causes; IV. If both the statements I and II are effects of independent causes; and V. If both the statements I and II are effects of some common cause.

Question On Analytical Reasoning

Statement I: It is the aim of the city's civic authority to get air pollution reduced by 20% in the next two months. Statement II: The number of asthma cases in the city is constantly increasing.

Difficulty : Moderate

Average Time : 72 Seconds

Analytical Reasoning Questions Options

1. If statement I is the cause and statement II is its effect
2. If Statement II is the cause and statement I is its effect
3. If both the statements I and II are independent causes
4. If both the statements I and II are effects of independent causes
5. If both the statements I and II are effects of some common cause

Analytical Reasoning Questions Solution

The correct answer is **Option 2** i.e **If Statement II is the cause and statement I is its effect.**

Understanding

The increase in the number of asthma cases must have alerted the authorities to take action to control air pollution that triggers the disease.

Hence the correct answer is **If Statement II is the cause and statement I is its effect.**
