Comprehension On Analytical Reasoning Questions

Direction: In the following question, a statement is given & then two assumptions – I & II are given. You have to decide which of the following assumptions are implicit in the information on the basis of the given statement and the assumptions given after it.

Question On Analytical Reasoning

Statement: Government has announced a relief package for all the draught-hit farmers and advised the state government to put in a mechanism for disbursement. Assumptions: I. The Government may be able to identify all the farmers affected by drought in the country. II. The states may be able to put in place the system for the disbursement of relief packages to the affected farmers.

Difficulty : Moderate

Average Time : 60 Seconds

Analytical Reasoning Questions Options

1. If only assumption I is implicit
2. If only assumption II is implicit
3. If either assumption I or II is implicit
4. If neither assumption I nor II is implicit
5. If both assumption I and II are implicit

Analytical Reasoning Questions Solution

The correct answer is **Option 2** i.e. **If only assumption II is implicit**

Understanding

Assumptions:

I. The Government may be able to identify all the farmers affected by drought in the country.

False (It is not possible to identify all the farmers in the country manually)

II. The states may be able to put in place the system for the disbursement of relief packages to the affected farmers. **True** (Through this method farmers will get their relief)

Hence, the correct answer is **If only assumption II is implicit.**

1. Try to solve Analytical Reasoning Questions without taking any help from the solutions.
2. Analytical Reasoning Questions require proper usage of concept so firstly read the question thoroughly and then use the right concept.
3. In case you're not able to solve the question in less than 30 seconds in the exam then you should skip the question and move to the next question.
