Direction: In the following questions, the symbols @, &, %, \$ and # are used with the following meaning as illustrated below: 'P @ Q' means 'P is not smaller than Q' 'P & Q' means 'P is neither greater than nor equal to Q' 'P# Q' means 'P is neither greater than nor smaller than Q' 'P \$ Q' means 'P is not greater than Q' 'P % Q' means 'P is neither smaller than nor equal to Q'. Now in each of the following questions assuming the given statements to be true, find which of the given conclusions follow and give answer accordingly.

Question On Inequality

Statements: L %T @ V # R, X \$ W % P @ V Conclusion: I. X @ R II. V % X

Difficulty : Moderate

Average Time : 67 Seconds

Inequality Questions Options

1. Only conclusion I follows
2. Only conclusion II follows
3. Either conclusion I or II follows
4. Neither conclusion I nor II follows
5. Both conclusions I and II follow

Inequality Questions Solution

The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. **Either conclusion I or II follows**

Statements:

L %T @ V # R, X \$ W % P @ V

$L > T$ $V = R$, $X > P$ V

Conclusion:

I. $X @ R - X > R$ - **False** ($X > P$ $V = R$)

II. $V \% X - V > X$ - **False** ($X > P$ V)

Individually both conclusions are false, but there are all three signs (greater than, smaller than, and equal) between X and R ($V=R$). So, they made a complementary pair.

Hence the correct answer is **Either conclusion I or II is true.**

1. Try to solve Inequality Questions without taking any help from the solutions.
2. Inequality Questions require proper usage of concept so firstly read the question thoroughly and then use the right concept.
3. In case you're not able to solve the question in less than 30 seconds in the exam then you should skip the question and move to the next question.
