Step I - Words are arranged alphabetically according to the second letter of each word from the left to the right.

Step II - The letter having highest place value is replaced by its place value in each word.

Step III - All the digits are added in each word and written at the last of each word.

Step IV - Place value of each vowel in a word is added to the number in each word and then each word is written in ascending order according to the numbers from the left to the right. (if two words has the same number then they will be arranged alphabetically)
