Input: need 36 fruit 48 mango 19 summer 13 high 20

Which number/word will be at 5th position from right end in step IV?

Difficulty : Moderate

Input Output Questions Solution

The correct answer is **Option 2** i.e **20**

Two elements (One Word and One Number) are arranged in a single step at the extreme left end. After that again two elements are arranged to the immediate right of the elements arranged in the previous step.

All the words are arranged in alphabetical order and numbers are arranged in ascending order.

Input: need 36 fruit 48 mango 19 summer 13 high 20

Step I: fruit 13 need 36 48 mango 19 summer high 20

Step II: fruit 13 high 19 need 36 48 mango summer 20

Step III: fruit 13 high 19 mango 20 need 36 48 summer

Step IV: fruit 13 high 19 mango 20 need 36 summer 48

From the arrangement, it can be seen that '20' is at the 5th position from the right end in step V.

Hence, the correct answer is **20**.
