Match The Following Questions Solution

The correct answer is **option (2) i.e. A-E, B-F and C-D.**

- When we use ' neither ', we mention the opposite of that i.e. 'nor' action in the next phrase.
- The above is an example of parallelism so it should be 'neither encouraged nor examined'. **So, A-E are connected.**
- Traduce means to speak bad of or to tell lies about someone so as to damage his reputation. Therefore speaking

bad about someone is connected to politicians. **So, B-F are connected.**

- Get a word in edgeways means contribute to a conversation with difficulty because the other speaker talks incessantly.
 - Eg: Roz was talking so much that nobody else could get a word in edgeways.
 - Note: The American form of this idiom is "to get a word in edgewise".
- **So, C-D are connected.**
