Direction: Read the given information carefully and answer the following questions. Twelve people A, B, C, D, E, F, P, Q, R, S, T, and U live in four different countries Japan, France, Peru, and Russia. A maximum of Four and a minimum of two people live in the same country. A and Q doesn't live in the same country as B. P doesn't live in the same country as R. T and S live in two different countries but they don't live either in Peru or Russia. U and F live in the same country but it is neither Japan nor France. Only two people live in Peru. D and P don't live in the same country. D lives either in Peru or Russia. B lives in Russia. R and P live neither in France nor Japan. E and T live in the same country but neither in Russia nor France. C doesn't live in the same country as E. A doesn't live in France. Q doesn't live in the same country as T.

Who lives in Peru?

Puzzle Questions Options

1. D, P
2. C, R
3. A, S
4. P, C
5. D, R

Puzzle Questions Solution

The correct answer is **Option 5** i.e. D, R

R and P live neither in France nor Japan.

P doesn't live in the same country as R. (This means that at least one of R and P is living in Peru.)

Only two people live in Peru.

U and F live in the same country but it is neither Japan nor France.

(This means U and F live in Russia.)

B lives in Russia.

D and P don't live in the same country.

D lives either in Peru or Russia. (D & R lives in Peru and P lives in Russia.)

Japan

A and Q doesn't live in the same country as B.

T and S live in two different countries but they don't live either in Peru or Russia.

E and T live in the same country but neither in Russia nor France. (They live in Japan.)

A doesn't live in France. (A lives in Japan)

Q doesn't live in the same country as T.

C doesn't live in the same country as E. (Q and C live in France.)

Japan	E	T	A
France	Q	S	C
Peru	D	R	
Russia	U	F	B P

Hence the correct answer is D, R.
