Comprehension On Puzzle Questions

Direction: Read the given information carefully and answer the following questions. Condition 1: If "Ram is good" is coded as "34 30 40" then what will be the code for "We all are happy." Condition 2: If "They are fine" is coded as "100 18 84" then what will be the code for "She is not going." Note: 1. Different logic is applied to both conditions. 2. Find the codes for each sentence based on that.

Question On Puzzle

Arrange the codes of the given sentences "We all are happy." and "She is not going." in descending order, then find the sum of the second number from the left end and the third number from the right end.

Difficulty : Moderate

2. 175

Puzzle Questions Solution

The correct answer is **Option 4** i.e. **182**

Condition 1: If "Ram is good" is coded as "34 30 40".

i.e. Word is coded as the sum of the place value

(i) If the sum of the place value of all the letters is even then the sum is increased by 2.

(ii) If the sum of the place value of all the letters is odd then the sum is decreased by 1.

$$WE = 23 + 5 = 28$$

$$ALL = 1 + 12 + 12 = 25$$

$$ARE = 1 + 18 + 5 = 24$$

$$HAPPY = 8 + 1 + 16 + 16 + 25 = 61$$

So, the code for "WE ALL ARE HAPPY" is "**30 24 26 60**".

Condition 2: If "They are fine" is coded as "100 18 84".

i.e. Word is coded as the product of the place value of the word's first and second last letter.

$$SHE = 19 \times 8 = 152$$

$$IS = 9 \times 9 = 81$$

$$NOT = 14 \times 15 = 210$$

$$GOING = 7 \times 14 = 98$$

So, the code for "SHE IS NOT GOING" is "**152 81 210 98**".

Arrange the codes of both sentences in descending order,

210 152 98 81 60 30 26 24

The second number from the left end = 152

The third number from the right end = 30

The sum is = $152 + 30 = 182$

Hence, the correct answer is "**182**".
