The correct answer is option 4 i.e. While social media platforms have revolutionized communication and

entertainment, some experts argue that greater regulation is necessary to address concerns about mental health and privacy.

This option accurately reflects the two main points made in the original sentences: the impact of social media on communication and entertainment, and the need for greater regulation due to concerns about mental health and privacy. The use of "while" effectively connects the two ideas and shows that they exist in contrast to each other.

- Option 1 uses "despite growing concerns" to link the two sentences, but this phrasing does not accurately reflect the original sentences, as the concerns are mentioned only in the second sentence and are not stated to be "growing."
- Option 2 uses "although" to link the sentences, but this phrasing does not capture the contrasting nature of the two ideas presented.
- Option 3 uses "despite the fact that" to link the sentences, but this phrasing is wordy and does not provide as clear of a connection between the two ideas as option 4.
- Option 5 is a bit awkward in its phrasing and does not connect the ideas as smoothly as option 4.






