## Sentence Connectors Questions Solution

The correct answer is **Option 1** i.e. **The majority of the world's energy still comes from fossil fuels, but many countries are setting ambitious goals to transition to renewable energy due to concerns about climate change.**

The correct answer is option 1, which effectively connects the two ideas while preserving their meaning. The use of "but" emphasizes the contrast between the current reliance on fossil fuels and the push for greater use of renewable energy due to climate concerns. Option 3 is incorrect because it incorrectly places the emphasis on the continued reliance on fossil fuels, rather than the shift towards renewable energy. Option 2 and 5 are incorrect because they do not effectively connect the two ideas presented. Option 4 is incorrect because it places too much emphasis on the minority of countries setting goals for renewable energy, rather than the larger picture of fossil fuel usage.
