Sentence Jumbles Questions Solution

The correct answer is option 2, i.e. CDBA

1. Sentence C gives us an introduction to the passage, that is **waste management**. No other sentence here gives us any basic introduction whereas they denote some continuation of a sense or meaning.
2. Sentence D gives us more information regarding waste management, prevalent issues to be specific. It cannot begin because it does not introduce us to any basic idea before addressing the issues. Hence, it will occur later in the passage.
3. Sentence B starts with the introduction of an example by using the prefix '**for instance**'. This means this will come later in the passage to support the argument made by the earlier sentences.
4. Sentence A would be the conclusive statement as it provides another example but with an adverb '**too**', which

means it wants to further add to the meaning of the previous statement. We can tell it is the end statement as it mentions the '**national capital too**' after the mention of '**Mumbai**' (state after state).

This arrangement makes perfect sense entirely and gives us a sequential meaning, hence becoming the correct answer to our question.

1. Try to solve Sentence Jumbles Questions without taking any help from the solutions.
2. Sentence Jumbles Questions require proper usage of concept so firstly read the question thoroughly and then use the right concept.
