The correct answer is option 4, i.e. CADB

- 1. Sentence C introduces us to a basic idea or meaning. So, it'll occur as the beiginning sentence of the passage. In this case it is the working-lifestyle of a carpenter named Ashok Kumar.
- 2. Sentence A adds more information to Ashok's lifestyle (the amount of money he makes) so it is apparent that this sentence comes right after Ashok's introduction.
- 3. Sentence D reels in another sub-topic, that is the halt of India's informal economy due to the covid-19 pandemic. So, it is to be used at third place to add more meaning to the passage. It is also apparent that the sentence will come at third place and not first due to the usage of the conjunction 'but'. Conjunctions don't naturally appear at the very start

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of any passage.

4. Sentence B will be the concluding one as it talks about the condition of the lives of people like Ashok due to the virus-outbreak and the aftermath of a sinking or paused economy.

This sequence provides a fluent meaning to the passage and puts all the figures of speech at their correct places, hence making it the correct answer to our question.
