The question below consists of a set of labelled sentences. These sentences, when properly sequenced form a coherent paragraph. Select the most logical order of sentences from among the options. P: We may see alcohol and tobacco advertisements everywhere, on television, in newspaper, on street ads card etc. Q: But we know the truth is alcohol and cigarette are harmful for people's health and sometimes it may bring bad effects to self-impression. R: Alcohol ads usually create several feints to tell people that alcohol is good for people and induce people to drink. S: On the other hand, the malign influence of advertisements shows smoking as something "cool".

Difficulty : Moderate

1. PRSQ
2. PSQR
3. QRSP
4. RSPQ

Sentence Jumbles Questions Solution

The correct answer is option 1, i.e. PRSQ.

1. Sentence P provides an introduction of the context, that is the advertisements on alcohol and tobacco.
2. Sentence R shall follow because it adjoins details on alcohol and how such advertisements influence human psychology.
3. Sentence S shall appear at third place as it adds extra information (sort of a twist in plot) for the given passage.
4. Sentence Q will be the final statement because it provides a point (truth) about the dire consequences of such items even if the advertisements tend to normalize their consumption. This point can be treated as a conclusive one for the passage.

This arrangement follows a sequential manner, where the information/detail gets added without losing fluency or any sense/meaning in the narration.

1. Try to solve Sentence Jumbles Questions without taking any help from the solutions.
2. Sentence Jumbles Questions require proper usage of concept so firstly read the question thoroughly and then use the right concept.
3. In case you're not able to solve the question in less than 30 seconds in the exam then you should skip the question and move to the next question.
