

# Syllogism Questions Overview

## Comprehension On Syllogism Questions

Direction: In the following question three statements are followed by three conclusions numbered I, II, and III. You have to take the given statements to be true even if they seem to be at variance from commonly known facts. Read all the statements and decide which of the given conclusion/conclusions logically follows from the given statements.

### Question On Syllogism

Statements: Only a few socks are shoes. No shirt is black. All shirt is shoes. Conclusions: I. Some shoes can be black. II. Some shoes are not socks. III. Some black is socks.

Difficulty : Moderate

Average Time : 52 Seconds

## Syllogism Questions Options

1. Both conclusions I and II follow
2. Both conclusions II and III follow
3. Only conclusion I follows
4. All conclusions follow
5. None of the conclusions follow

## Syllogism Questions Solution

The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. **Only Conclusion I follows**

Understanding

The least possible Venn diagram is:



**Conclusions:**

I. Some shoes can be black **True** (The possibility is true as the remaining portion of Shoes which is not Shirt can be part of Black).



II. Some shoes are not socks **False** (It is possible but not definite as shoes do not have a negative relation with socks).

III. Some black is socks **False** (This is possible but not definite as no direct relationship between the two elements is given).

Hence, **Only Conclusion I follows.**

## Syllogism Questions Tips and Tricks



1. Try to solve Syllogism Questions without taking any help from the solutions.
2. Syllogism Questions require proper usage of concept so firstly read the question thoroughly and then use the right concept.
3. In case you're not able to solve the question in less than 30 seconds in the exam then you should skip the question and move to the next question.
