Question On Syllogism

Statements: I. No Apple is mango. II. Some mango is pear. III. All pears are grapes. Conclusions: I. Some mango is grapes. II. No apple is grapes. III. Some pear is not apple. IV. All grapes are mango.

Difficulty : Moderate

Average Time : 52 Seconds

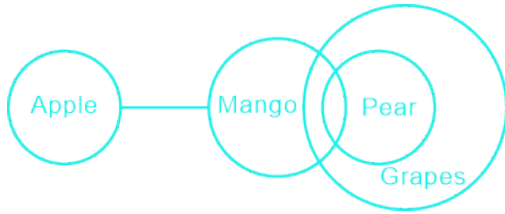
Syllogism Questions Options

1. Only Conclusion I and II follow
2. Only Conclusion II and III follow
3. Only Conclusion I and III follow
4. Only Conclusion II and IV follow

Syllogism Questions Solution

The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. **Only Conclusion I and III follow**

The possible Venn diagram is



Conclusions:

- I. Some mango is grapes. **True** (As some mango is pear and all pears are grapes so some mango is grapes is true.)
- II. No apple is grapes. **False** (As no direct relation is given between apples and grapes.)
- III. Some pear is not apple. **True** (As no apple is mango and some mango is pear then some pear that is mango is not apple. So, some pear is not apple is true.)
- IV. All grapes are mango. **False** (It is possible but not definite so all grapes are mango is false.)

Clearly, Conclusions I and III follow.

Hence, the correct answer is **Only Conclusion I and III follow.**

Syllogism Questions Tips and Tricks



1. Try to solve Syllogism Questions without taking any help from the solutions.
2. Syllogism Questions require proper usage of concept so firstly read the question thoroughly and then use the right concept.
3. In case you're not able to solve the question in less than 30 seconds in the exam then you should skip the question and move to the next question.
