



# Syllogism Questions Overview

You have to take the given statements to be true even if they seem to be at variance from commonly known facts. Read all the statements and decide which of the given conclusion/conclusions logically follows from the given statements.

### Question On Syllogism

Statements: All flowers are clouds. No clouds are rain. All rains are stars. Conclusions: I. All flowers being stars is a possibility. II. All rain being flower is a possibility. III. Some cloud being rain is a possibility.

Difficulty : Moderate

Average Time : 53 Seconds

## Syllogism Questions Options

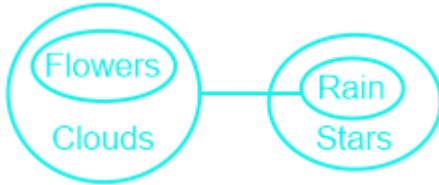
1. Only I follows
2. Only II follows
3. Only III follows
4. All I, II and III follow
5. Neither I, II nor III follows

## Syllogism Questions Solution

The correct answer is **Option 1** i.e. **Only Conclusion I follows**

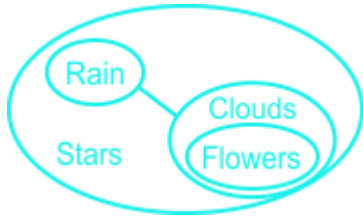
Understanding

The least possible Venn diagram for the given statements is drawn below:



**Conclusions:**

I. All flowers being stars is a possibility: **True**  
(The possibility is true, as all flowers can be part of remaining stars, which is not rain).



II. All rain being flower is a possibility: **False**  
( All flowers are clouds & No clouds are rain hence, no rain is flower).

III. Some cloud being rain is a possibility: **False** (This is not possible, as clouds and rains have negative relationship with each other).

Hence, the correct answer is **Only Conclusion I follows.**

## Syllogism Questions Tips and Tricks



1. Try to solve Syllogism Questions without taking any help from the solutions.
2. Syllogism Questions require proper usage of concept so firstly read the question thoroughly and then use the right concept.
3. In case you're not able to solve the question in less than 30 seconds in the exam then you should skip the question and move to the next question.
