Verb form: is / am / are + past participle form of the

verb

Examples

Examples

Simple present tense They speak English here.

English is spoken here.

He speaks English.

English is spoken by him.

Verb form: is/am/are + -ing form of the verb

Verb form: is/am/are + being + past participle form

of the verb

Present continuous tense

Examples

Examples

She is writing a letter.

A letter is being written by her.

I am learning my lessons.

My lessons are being learnt by me.

You are making a cake.

A cake is being made by you.

Verb form: has/have + past participle form of

the verb

Examples:

Verb form: has/have + been + past participle form

of the verb

resent perfect tense

Examples:

I have written a novel. A novel has been written by me.

She has finished the job. The job has been finished by her.

You have written letters. Letters have been written by you.

Verb form: was/were + past participle form of the

verb

Simple past

Examples: Examples:

I wrote a letter. A letter was written by me.

Ram broke a glass. A glass was broken by Ram.

You missed the chance. The chance was missed by you.

Verb form: was/were + being + past participle form

of the verb

Verb form: was/were + -ing form of the verb

Past continuous tense

Examples

I was learning my lessons.

She was writing a report.

They were making toys.

Examples

My lessons were being learnt by me.

A report was being written by her.

Toys were being made by them.

Verb form: had + past participle form of the

verb

Verb form: had + been + past participle form of the

verb

Past perfect tense

Examples

Examples:

I had finished the project.

The project had been finished by me.

She had learned her lessons.

Her lessons had been learned by her.

Verb form: will/shall + first form of the verb

Verb form: will/shall + be + past participle form of

the verb

Simple future tense

Examples

Examples:

I will finish the job.

The job will be finished by me.

She will solve the problem.

The problem will be solved by her.

Verb form: will/shall + have + past participle

form of the verb

Verb form: will/shall + have + been + past

participle form of the verb

Future perfect

Examples

I will have finished the job.

She will have solved the problem.

Examples

The job will have been finished by me.

The problem will have been solved by her.

Hence, the remaining options are incorrect.


- 2. Voice Questions require proper usage of concept so firstly read the question thoroughly and then use the right concept.
