## Voice Questions Options

1. The password is never known to Cynthia.
2. The password was never known to Cynthia.
3. The password never known to Cynthia.
4. The password was never knew to Cynthia.

## Voice Questions Solution

The correct answer is **“The password was never known to Cynthia.”**

The following table has the rules for conversion from active voice to passive voice:

Tense	Active voice	Passive voice
-------	--------------	---------------

<p>Simple present tense</p>	<p>Verb form: first form of the verb</p> <p>Examples</p> <p>They speak English here.</p> <p>He speaks English.</p>	<p>Verb form: is / am / are + past participle form of the verb</p> <p>Examples</p> <p>English is spoken here.</p> <p>English is spoken by him.</p>
<p>Present continuous tense</p>	<p>Verb form: is/am/are + -ing form of the verb</p> <p>Examples</p> <p>She is writing a letter.</p> <p>I am learning my lessons.</p> <p>You are making a cake.</p>	<p>Verb form: is/am/are + being + past participle form of the verb</p> <p>Examples</p> <p>A letter is being written by her.</p> <p>My lessons are being learnt by me.</p> <p>A cake is being made by you.</p>
<p>resent perfect tense</p>	<p>Verb form: has/have + past participle form of the verb</p> <p>Examples:</p> <p>I have written a novel.</p> <p>She has finished the job.</p> <p>You have written letters.</p>	<p>Verb form: has/have + been + past participle form of the verb</p> <p>Examples:</p> <p>A novel has been written by me.</p> <p>The job has been finished by her.</p> <p>Letters have been written by you.</p>

<p>Simple past</p>	<p>Verb form: past tense form of the verb</p> <p>Examples:</p> <p>I wrote a letter.</p> <p>Ram broke a glass.</p> <p>You missed the chance.</p>	<p>Verb form: was/were + past participle form of the verb</p> <p>Examples:</p> <p>A letter was written by me.</p> <p>A glass was broken by Ram.</p> <p>The chance was missed by you.</p>
<p>Past continuous tense</p>	<p>Verb form: was/were + -ing form of the verb</p> <p>Examples</p> <p>I was learning my lessons.</p> <p>She was writing a report.</p> <p>They were making toys.</p>	<p>Verb form: was/were + being + past participle form of the verb</p> <p>Examples</p> <p>My lessons were being learnt by me.</p> <p>A report was being written by her.</p> <p>Toys were being made by them.</p>
<p>Past perfect tense</p>	<p>Verb form: had + past participle form of the verb</p> <p>Examples</p> <p>I had finished the project.</p> <p>She had learned her lessons.</p>	<p>Verb form: had + been + past participle form of the verb</p> <p>Examples:</p> <p>The project had been finished by me.</p> <p>Her lessons had been learned by her.</p>

<p>Simple future tense</p>	<p>Verb form: will/shall + first form of the verb</p> <p>Examples</p> <p>I will finish the job.</p> <p>She will solve the problem.</p>	<p>Verb form: will/shall + be + past participle form of the verb</p> <p>Examples:</p> <p>The job will be finished by me.</p> <p>The problem will be solved by her.</p>
<p>Future perfect</p>	<p>Verb form: will/shall + have + past participle form of the verb</p> <p>Examples</p> <p>I will have finished the job.</p> <p>She will have solved the problem.</p>	<p>Verb form: will/shall + have + been + past participle form of the verb</p> <p>Examples</p> <p>The job will have been finished by me.</p> <p>The problem will have been solved by her.</p>

Hence, the remaining options are incorrect.

1. Try to solve Voice Questions without taking any help from the solutions.
2. Voice Questions require proper usage of concept so firstly read the question thoroughly and then use the right concept.
3. In case you're not able to solve the question in less than 30 seconds in the exam then you should skip the question and move to the next question.
